Brush, roll, spray or airbrush



### **Drying Times:**

Drying time is best when temperature is above 65°F. Between 50°F and 65°F, drying time is much slower. Paint will not completely dry below 50°F.

# **Compatible Topcoats:**

For increased protection against ultraviolet light, topcoat with 220-F 1-Shot Fluorescent UV Topcoat. Two coats of 220-F will produce a high gloss finish.

### **Equipment Cleaning:**

Clean equipment with mineral spirits.

Clean brushes thoroughly with 1-Shot 40004 Brush Cleaner then rinse by stirring brush in a clean solution.
